The finished textile products are bales of fibre or boxes of yarns. The markets supplied include household textiles, floorcoverings, automotive, outdoor sports, geotextiles and technical textile products.

We are fully committed to comply with the requirements of the ISO 9001: 2015 quality management system standard and to continuously improve the effectiveness of our quality management system.
